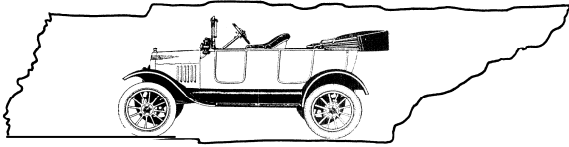

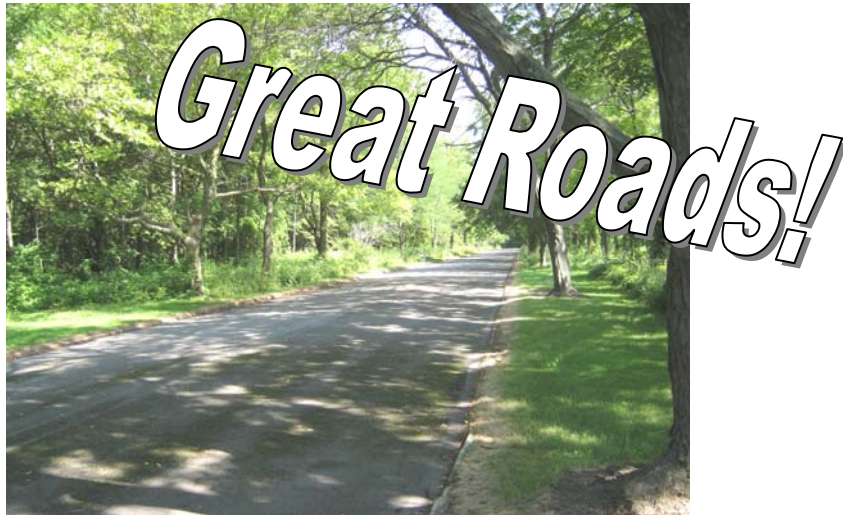
Always document you projects, tours, etc, and forward it for inclusion into the newsletter.

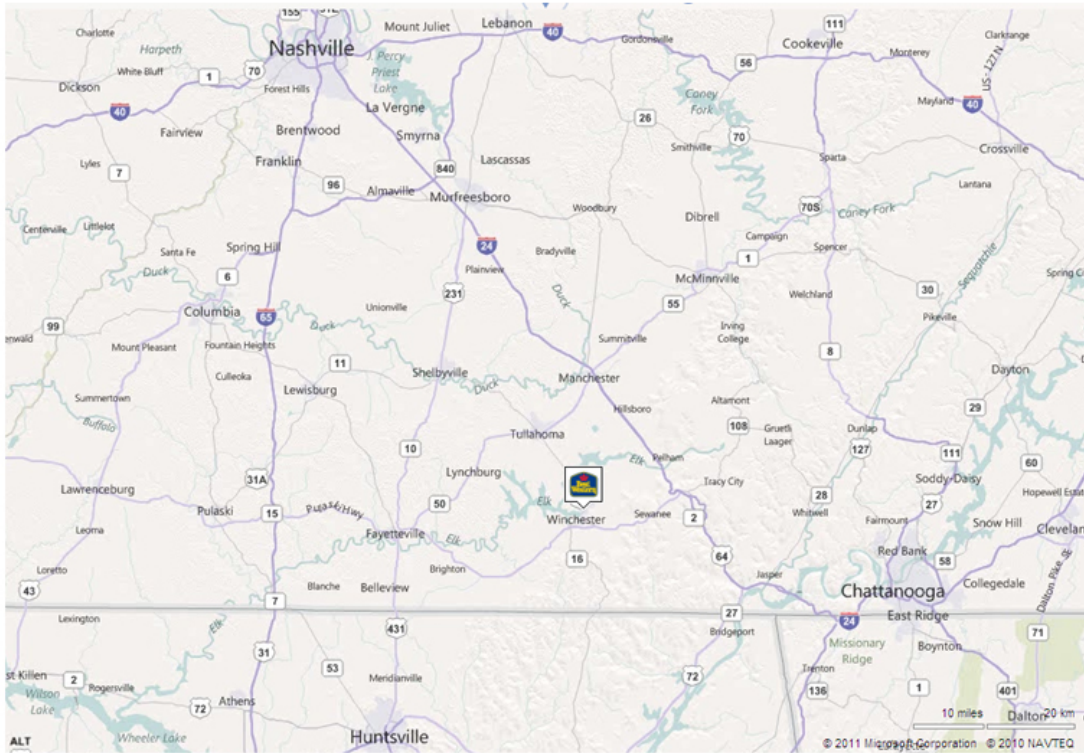
