The Tennessee T's Spring Tour 2017 The Natchez Trace Parkway (May 12 – May 21) Hosted by Mark and Paula Gember

Mark and I have taken hundreds of road trips over the last 30 years, and the Natchez Trace is by far one of our all-time favorites. The Trace became part of the National Park System in 1938, is designated a National Scenic By-way and All-American Road, and one of America's 10 best biking roads. The Trace stretches 444 miles and encompasses 10,000 years of North American history, linking Natchez with Nashville and some of the most beautiful terrain in the states of Mississippi, Alabama and Tennessee.

In 1801 the Trace was designated a national postal road for mail delivery between Nashville and Natchez. General Andrew Jackson, Jefferson Davis, James Audubon, Meriwether Lewis (who died on the Trace in 1809), and Ulysses S. Grant are among the famous Americans to have traveled the Natchez Trace. Several months ago, we learned that **the Tennessee T's was the first Model T club to tour the Natchez Trace**.

The annual tour started and ended in Nashville, Tennessee. As we understand it, the last time the club ran the Trace was nearly a decade ago. Mark and I wanted to bring the Natchez Trace tour back to the Tennessee T's!

Since so many club members work full-time or go to school, we challenged ourselves to set up this tour so that it could be enjoyed, all or in part, by as many members as possible. We chose Tupelo for the starting point since it is roughly the halfway point on the Trace, and established three route options to choose from:

- The 6-day South Route runs down to Natchez, spends a day in Vicksburg and then runs back to Tupelo Refer to the colored schedule on the calendar
- The 3-day North Route runs up and over to Waynesboro, TN, then up to Nashville and back to Tupelo Refer to the colored schedule on the calendar
- The 9-day Full Route is a combination of the 6-day South Route followed by the 3-day North Route Refer to the colored schedule on the calendar

No matter which option you choose, everyone will be running the same route on the same day.

The Parkway is a paved, well-maintained two lane. The 50 mph max speed limit keeps modern traffic to a minimum. There are more than 100 points of interest and exhibits along the Trace, making it an easy self-guided route. Since there are no modern amenities on the Trace, our tour book provides detailed directions to and from hotel destinations, lunch stops, and midpoint gas stations.

- Friday, May 12 (arrival day) Unload trailers and hotel check-in. Take a short drive to the Natchez Trace Parkway Visitor Center before 5pm to learn about the history of the Trace.
 Trailers are parked less than < ½ mile from the hotel and will remain here until the end of the tour. Cars for the 6-day South Trace will also be arriving at the hotel.
- Saturday, May 13 (Day 1) South from Tupelo to Jackson. Lunch stop in Koscuisko, MS, birthplace of Oprah Winfrey. Route highlights: Chickasaw Village Site; Tockshish (midway point on the early 1800's postal route); Owl Creek Mounds (early Indian); and Old Trace (two sections of original trace). Cars running the South Trace will also be on this route.
- Sunday, May 14 (Day 2) South from Jackson to Natchez/Vidalia, LA. Lunch stop at all you can eat fried chicken buffet in Lorman. Route highlights: Magnum Mound (Indian mound); Sunken Trace (short trail through a deeply eroded section); Mount Locust (restored plantation & historic stand).
 Cars running the South Trace will also be on this route.
- Monday, May 15 (Day 3) North from Vidalia back through Natchez, then along four off-trace routes to Vicksburg. Route highlights: Emerald Mound (built between 1200 and 1730); 1790's church, cemetery, several antebellum homes; Windsor Ruins; Port Gibson; picnic lunch at Grand Gulf Military Park.
 Cars running the South Trace will also be on this route.
- Tuesday, May 16 (Day 4) Full Day in Vicksburg. Old Depot Museum (diorama of battlefield); Coca Cola museum, riverfront murals; Vicksburg National Battlefield and Cemetery; Cairo Museum (showcases an ironclad Civil War gunboat that was raised from the muddy Mississippi River bottom in the 1960's.)
 Cars running the South Trace will also be on this route.
- Wednesday, May 17 (Day 5) Short travel day. Morning in Vicksburg, then north back to hotel in Jackson. Late day gathering at the Old Trace Park near Ross Barrett Reservoir for a picnic or manifold cooker meal. Visit Mississippi Craft Center/Quilt Museum across from the Old Trace Park entrance. Cars running the South Trace will also be on this route.
- Thursday, May 18 (Day 6) Leave Jackson and head north back to Tupelo. Lunch at Council House Café, (circa 1820's). Trace highlights: Cypress Swamp; Jeff Bisby (one of Mississippi's highest points, 603 ft); Old Trace; Bynum Mounds (built 1,800-2,500 yrs ago); Tupelo National Battlefield.
 Cars running the South Trace will be at hotel for the night and head home tomorrow.
 Cars for the 3-day North Trace will be arriving at the hotel.
- Friday, May 19 (Day 7) Highlights: Confederate Gravesites; Old Trace; Pharr Mounds; Tenn-Tom Waterway; Bear Creek Mound; Colbert Ferry; and Sunken Trace. Staying at hotel in Waynesboro, TN. Cars running the North Trace will also be on this route.
- Saturday, May 20 (Day 8) Leave Waynesboro and return to the Trace, continuing north to hotel in Nashville. Lunch stop in Leiper's Fork.
